

COVID-19 POLICIES



The following policies have been developed through Skate Ontario, York Region Health and the Town of Georgina and are current as of September 23rd. These policies may change at any time.



- All parents/guardians must sign the online COVID-19 Assumption of Risk waiver upon registration.
- ONE caregiver is allowed to enter the building with their skater **if they are ten or younger**. Skates may be tied by caregivers of skaters ten and under on a designated chair.
- Caregivers who enter must sit rinkside in an assigned zone, wearing a mask and stay physically distanced.
- Skaters must arrive **20 minutes** before EVERY session and line up outside for screening and sign-in. Cell phone numbers of parents/guardians will be recorded each session in the event of emergency. Doors will be locked by arena staff once the last screened skater has entered and **late skaters will not be granted access under any circumstances**.
- Skaters need to arrive fully dressed and wearing a mask. They may remove their mask right before taking the ice (but should bring it out to the ice if they plan to use the **harness**).
- Arena staff and GSC volunteers will escort skaters to and from the ice surface and must be treated with **respect** at all times.
- Skaters are not permitted to go on and off the ice and should bring everything they need (water, gloves, etc.).
- Physical distancing must be practiced on the ice at all times.
- Members who do not follow these policies will be unable to continue with their current program and/or future sessions.
